THE REVD RICHARD WRITES Knowing Your Worshipping Community is the title of a piece written by Barry Hill about one of the most useful tools a church can develop about its worshippers. He writes this: 'Growing churches are places where people are known. God knows us by name. We know that churches who keep an up to date list of who is part of the worshipping community and regularly review it to note and respond to who has joined, who has left, who might be thinking about leaving, who has particular pastoral concerns which need greater attention and the like, are much more likely to grow.

'Obviously we don't love and care for each other in order to see our churches grow, we do it in response to the love, compassion and welcome we have known from God, but being more intentional about it is also a major contributing factor to numerical and spiritual growth. As attendance and membership patterns, and missional and pastoral needs change, less prominence is being given to traditionally used measures, like Electoral Roll and Usual Sunday Attendance, and much more to the overall size of, and change within, the worshipping community. This has many advantages, not least it includes all ages and is based on those who regularly worship as part of a given community (or would if illness did not prevent).

'That the response of some churches when asked has been 'we don't know where to start' underscores the need for such a list and its regular use. So, whilst the measure is important for diocesan life and will take much greater prominence in the years to come, the missional practice for the local church which makes measuring it possible is significantly more important. We are reminded in the scriptures and at some of the liminal points in our lives that God calls us by name. The church is called to mirror God in knowing the names of those He has sent to be in fellowship together.'
