THE REVD RICHARD WRITES: Good news at last! I am very pleased to report that the Church Commissioners have received no opposing arguments and that the 'proposal' which has been advertised since January now becomes the 'scheme' with regard to St Guthlac's becoming a parish in its own right within the incumbency of Knighton. Why is this so important to this Church? I am just making a few simple points. They are not a conclusive list.

- A Conventional District is not a permanent but only a temporary arrangement. A negotiated 'outcome' was required. The pastoral measure will make the Conventional District a parish in its own right. This is not a temporary but a permanent arrangement.
- 2) The arrangement was negotiated and concluded with the unanimous approval of Knighton PCC representing the interests of the parish and church of St Mary Magdalen. The expectation is that relations between the two churches will continue to improve as a result of the stability provided by the pastoral measure.
- 3) Under Church law a Conventional District is not supposed to have its own PCC but a DCC. This is not how we have operated but the status of the PCC as custodian of the interests of the parish and Church of St Guthlac cannot now be questioned in the future.
- 4) Under the pastoral measure the Revd Richard is relicensed as minister of the parish Church of St Guthlac. He remains as before the sole ordained ministerial presence in the Church.
- 5) In all future reviews of parochial organization, St Guthlac's will be treated on a basis of equality with other PCCs. This will not guarantee the outcome of any discussions, but it does mean that the viewpoint of the PCC representing the congregation as a whole cannot be ignored.
