The Archdeacon agreed that he would help us look for a Non Stipendiary Priest – or 'Associate Vicar' who would work with / under Adrian in the Benefice with special responsibility for St Guthlac's. Following his advice we now have to make some additions as well as prepare a concise attractive document with photographs. The aim is to achieve this by Easter.

"Darkness Falls" - a dramatic telling of John's Gospel: The acclaimed Saltmine Theatre Company are bringing their latest production to Leicester on Thursday 15th March, 7.30pm, at the Tudor Grange Samworth Academy, Trenant Road (also the home of St Christopher's Church, Saffron Lane). "Darkness Falls" is a remarkable re-imagining of the Gospel of John and is, by turns, moving, funny, poetic and fantastical. The production mixes vivid storytelling with beautiful live music to bring us a timeless story as we've never seen it before.

This gritty performance (suitable for teenagers upwards) is a compelling introduction to John's Gospel for those with little Christian background and also a fresh and provocative retelling for those of us who know the New Testament well. During the day they will be performing to all the Year 10 pupils at the Academy. It is therefore exactly the sort of initiative that our churches should be supporting.
