The Collect and Readings for the Fifth Sunday of Lent

Most merciful God, who by the death and resurrection of your Son Jesus Christ delivered and saved the world: grant that by faith in him who suffered on the cross we may triumph in the power of his victory; through Jesus Christ your Son our Lord, who is alive and reigns with you, in the unity of the Holy Spirit, one God, now and for ever. Praying for each other: As we move into a new month, please pray for other members of our church community, and especially those whose surnames begin with M, N, O and P. Pray that we would all grow in faith, hope and love – in our hearts and minds but also in the actions of our lives.

Praying for the World - Please pray for all those suffering after the earthquake in Myanmar and Thailand.
